



6ft by 4ft Raised bed planting plan No.1

14 or 21 inch high 6ft by 4ft Raised Bed Planting Plan No.1

The plant choices start at the back of the bed with the tallest plants with height gradually decreasing as you move towards the front. The bed should be placed facing south if possible to take best advantage of available light.

You will need to add a trellis or pea and bean net to the back of this bed to support the maincrop and sugarsnap peas. This can be retrofitted to the bed using our trellis kit or you can order a bed including trellis and mesh posts.

Planting key

Please see below the planting plan for the crops included in this bed.

1 1 per square		Plant one plant in the centre of each square foot.	5 5 per square	 5 on trellis	Place 5 plants along the edge of each square.
2 2 per square		Divide square diagonally into 2 equal squares.	16 16 per square		Divide into 16 equal squares.
4 4 per square		Divide square foot into 4 equal squares.	24 24 per square		Divide square into 4 and plant 4 bunches of 6.
